

More Practice 11

Let's number the three questions of <u>the last tutorial</u>, Examples 88 to 100. There are two more practices here:

- **Example 101.** Let $\Sigma = \{0,1,2\}$. Draw an FSA (NFSA or DFSA) to accept all strings that the following *regex* accepts: $0+01+(12)^*$
- **Example 102.** Let $\Sigma = \{0,1,2,3\}$. Draw an FSA (NFSA or DFSA) to accept all strings that the following regex accepts: $0^*(1+23+2)(1+2+23)^*$
- **Example 103.** Let $\Sigma = \{a, b\}$. Write a regular expression to accept all strings that the following FSA accepts.
